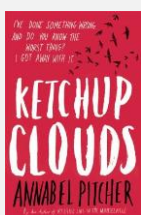
REAL-LIFE



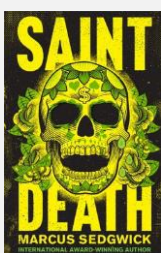

Judith can't speak, following an horrific ordeal. She is now shunned by her community. When they are attacked, Judith must choose between living in silence or finding her voice.

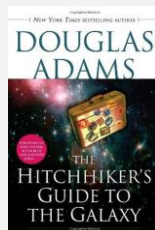


Teenager Zoe has a dark and terrible secret. One day she starts to tell her story in letters to a man on Death Row.

Full of hilarious coming-of-age moments and Rowell's ingenious humour. Popular book.

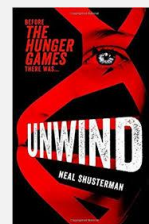
ESCAPIST



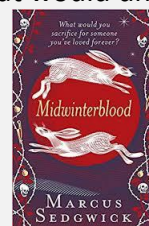
Before, she lived inside the fence, she was never allowed to leave the property, never allowed to speak her mind. Before the fire came.
