COVID Catch Up Spending Statement 2020 2021

Purpose

The government COVID-19 catch-up premium was established to mitigate the effects of the unique disruption to education caused by COVID19 pandemic.

This additional school funding was designated to enable schools to lead on specific activities to support students to catch up for lost teaching time. Schools were guided in developing best practice through the Education Endowment Foundation and this research as informed all approaches at the school. The focus of spending at the Archer Academy was based on the needs of students identified as disadvantaged and vulnerable.
